## Tollgate Association December Board Meeting

- The November meeting minutes were approved by the board via e-mail and the minutes were posted prior to the Nov 14<sup>th</sup> Tollgate Association Annual Meeting. The annual meeting minutes were reviewed and approved with minor changes. They will be updated and forwarded for posting on the website.
- 2. Treasurer's Report:
  - The committee reviewed the 2010 budget status, noting that expenses continue at anticipated levels with the Association's year end net worth remaining above \$11,000. The annual \$1,400 association dues for 2011 are due January 1<sup>st</sup> and considered late after 31 January payable to the treasurer, Bob Donaldson.
- 3. Committee Reports:
  - Social The Holiday Party Potluck will be held next Sunday December 12<sup>th</sup> from 5 to 8 PM at Ana's #125. Thanks to Tracy, Cindy and Anki for setting up this event with Ana. Wynne Hogle volunteered to serve and at least one more Social Committee member is being sought.
  - Landscape Marie Murray sent in her report via e-mail, saying that the final plantings of 2010 have now been completed. New shrubs were planted at #111 and one additional bush was planted at #135. Costs were within budget.
  - Tree Bob mentioned that the pecan tree in front of #118 has already been treated for borers – it will require another treatment in the spring. The sweet gum tree in front of #125 will be cut down in the next few weeks. Next step in that process is for the city to send out an employee to do a final look at the tree, then we can have it removed. The Austrian pines in front of #101 will come down next spring.
  - Architecture Garry reported that no new requests for exterior home maintenance were submitted.

- 4. Old Business:
  - Bob commented that he will construct a mock up of the Tollgate front entrance sign to get a sense of the right size and style for the community. If the mock-up is deemed satisfactory, a professional firm will create and install the final signage.
