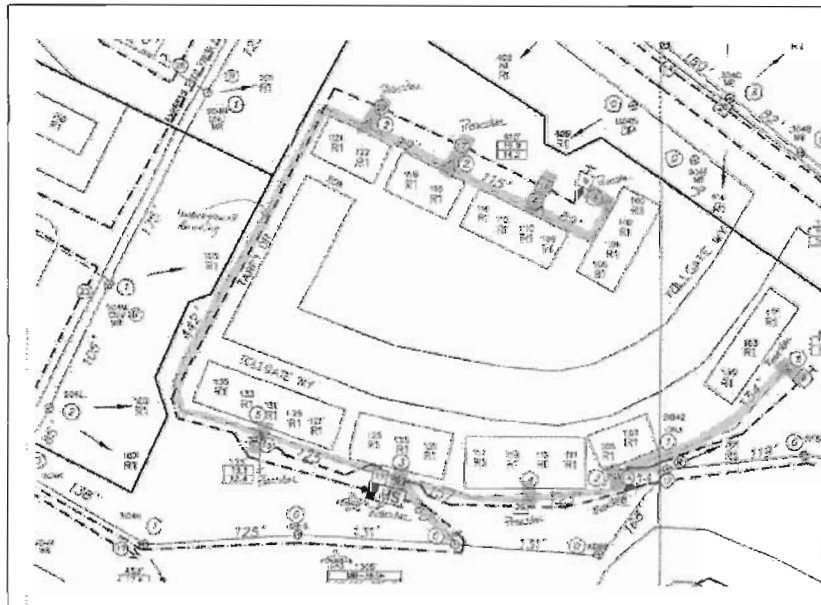
Dear Homeowner,

Some of you may have noticed workers from StarPower working in Tollgate recently and I apologize for not getting this note out sooner.

StarPower is a competitive communications company that is wiring the Falls Church area for fiber optic communications. They plan to provide telephone, Internet and cable TV services to compete with similar services from Verizon and Cox Cable.

Last month they approached the board with a proposal to wire Tollgate to provide these services at no cost to the community. After they are finished with the installation, they will offer the services to each homeowner. There is no obligation to purchase anything.

In the interest of increasing competition and expanding the services available to homeowners, the board approved their proposal with the provision that they make sure there is no service disruption to any existing Cox or Verizon customers. They will be working behind the properties and installing a cable and new pedestals similar to the existing Cox pedestals. In order to ensure that they don't cut any existing cables, StarPower had the utilities come in and mark where the cables are located so they are not disturbed. Here is a diagram of their planned installation:
