## Architecture Committee

The Architecture Committee has completed a lengthy effort to produce written guidelines to clarify and assist homeowners in following the procedures for exterior work or modifications to Tollgate homes. These guidelines reflect the requirements outlined in the Indenture of Covenants and are an attempt to assist homeowners with the procedure. They were presented to the Board, who unanimously voted to adopt them. The Guidelines are posted on the Tollgate web site and we encourage you to take a few minutes to review them.

#### Annual Meeting Update

The recommended changes to the Indenture of Covenants and By-Laws were voted upon and approved by 24 of 29 homeowners. The amended documents have been signed, notarized and will soon be filed at the Fairfax County Courthouse. Once the filing has taken place, copies will be distributed to all homeowners.

### Landscape and Tree Committees

The Landscape Committee is working with Merrifield Garden Center to create a Master Plan for Tollgate. It is the committee's hope to have the plan finalized this spring, to better guide our efforts to beautify Tollgate with appropriate and hardy plants in keeping with the original Williamsburg style.

The trees of Tollgate were recently inspected by an arborist and appropriate pruning was completed. Every homeowner was given an opportunity by email to request tree inspection, and the list of trees identified for work was similarly shared with the community. The trees on Tollgate property contribute both to the beauty and value of our community and every effort is made to ensure their health. Tollgate works carefully with the City arborist and complies with all requirements.
